ter for \$238,000, but their rep said the UVS-B-T model for \$6,780 should give accurate UVB readings.

Foote might consider getting this meter if he is interested in more than scaremongering.

The ozone layer was thinning at four percent per decade in the '80s and '90s, but most scientists believe it has begun to stabilize since 2003.

The chlorofluorocarbon chemicals that caused this were banned or gradually phased out by the Montreal Protocols in 1987.

Methane is not an ozone destroyer. Although it is a greenhouse gas, it has zero ozone destruction potential, according to the EPA.
